Who is the Ombudsman?

- An official who protects the rights and freedoms of people.

How does the Ombudsman protect children's rights?

- Ombudsman reviews the complaints about children whose rights have been violated, makes investigation and takes measures to restore them.
- Ombudsman carries out educational activities on children's rights.
- Ombudsman conducts monitoring to check the conditions and services in child facilities and to learn the situation of children.
- Ombudsman analyzes laws and documents related to children.
- Ombudsman makes proposals to state bodies and other institutions to protect children's rights.

YOU HAVE THE RIGHT to be protected from discrimination based on gender, race, language, status of your family, health and other grounds!



YOU HAVE THE RIGHT to be protected from violence!

YOU HAVE THE RIGHT to express your opinion and be heard on matters of interest!



YOU HAVE THE RIGHT to freedom, social security, recreation and protection from harmful influences!



YOU HAVE THE RIGHT to protection of your private life, secrets and personal information!



YOU HAVE THE RIGHT to receive support from your parents, teachers, adults or relevant institutions in case of any problems!
